#### CRIMINAL REFERENCE CHECKS

Parents may "walk in" to the OPP office in Embrun and make a request for a reference check so that they can volunteer in their child's school. When the check is complete you will receive a call to pick up the approved check. The form will have to be brought to school to go on file before you can volunteer in any capacity. A reminder when you go to apply for a CRC you must produce two pieces of identification - health card and SIN card is not acceptable.

We strongly advise that you obtain your CRC as early in the school year as possible so that you are able to volunteer at short notice, in the event a field trip or special event is taking place at the school. Process time at the OPP can take up to three weeks to complete.

If you already have a recent CRC on file at the school, you will need to sign an Offence Declaration at the school (new one required every year). **全位的企业的基础的基础的基础的基础的** 

#### Arrival At School Procedure

Buses arrive and staff members are on the yard for unloading at 8.55am. Please arrange for your children to arrive no earlier than 8.55am so they will have supervision while they are on the school property. For safety reasons, we ask for your cooperation in not going to your child's classroom. Please say your goodbyes at the front door.

SAFETY CONCERN: We would appreciate if parents would respect our signs at the front entrance of the school, cars should not be entering the front driveway and dropping students at the front door during bus drop off and pick up times. Please use the drop off area in the north parking lot on the corner of Mill St. and Craig St. Thank you!

Early Pick Up Procedure

On occasion, parents collect children at the end of the day instead of having them go home on the bus. Parents are welcome to come and pick their children up at this time but phone messages will not be passed on to students after 2.45 pm. It is helpful if parents would send a note in the agenda to teachers if students are being picked up at any time during the day. We endeavour to reduce interruptions during the academic day. A reminder please that formal dismissal is at 3.20 pm. and you must sign your child out at the office if they usually ride on the school bus. Please pick up your child at the office. For safety reasons parents are not permitted to go to classrooms or the yard to pick up their children. NO EXCEPTIONS PLEASE!

#### Late Students

Students arriving late at school must be signed in at the office by a parent/guardian. Students will take a late slip to their class.

#### Visitor Sign In

Visitors entering the school must report to the office. We ask that interruptions in the classrooms be kept to a minimum during the teaching day. If it is necessary to enter the academic area (for example, to make a presentation to a class) you must sign in and pick up a visitor pass. This has been put into place for your child's safety. #### Peanut Butter Substitutes

We would like to remind you that our school has students and/or staff with peanut allergies. We kindly ask that you do not send products that contain peanuts. There are food suppliers who are marketing peanut-free products that look, taste, and smell like peanut butter. These peanut butter substitute products can cause confusion and create an unsafe environment for our students and staff that are peanut anaphylactic. Therefore, due to the difficulty in differentiating between peanut butter and a peanut butter substitute, we do not allow these products in our school.





